Guidelines for Submissions to our Website

1. We welcome original submissions composed by members of OHALAH and the RPA that are consistent with all the terms of these guidelines. We also welcome announcements about books, articles, CD's and other products produced or published by members of OHALAH and the RPA. We also post links to the websites of OHALAH and RPA members and to the congregations, schools and other institutions where our members work, lead or serve. If a member has an article or product elsewhere on the web that is appropriate for our chevra, we may post a link to it as well.
2. If your submission is already on another website, please send an abstract, summary or blurb that contains a link to the full piece and we will post it on the OHALAH site. We do not post pieces in their entirety that are available elsewhere on the web.
3. ATTENTION WRITERS, MUSICIANS AND ARTISTS: We invite you to check out the ALEPH Books/Articles website at <https://www.aleph.org/books.htm>, and the ALEPH Artist Gallery and Music site at https://www.aleph.org/performing_artists.htm. Please send beautiful announcements about your work to ALEPH at aleph-admin@aleph.org, and ask to have your announcement published on the ALEPH site. Then send us the link and we will post the link on the OHALAH site. (ALEPH will ask you to sign a statement that you are subject to the ALEPH Ethics Code. As a member of OHALAH or the RPA, you are already subject to the OHALAH Ethics Code. There is no down side to being subject to both codes.)
4. Photos are welcome as part of articles and announcements. Please send as scanned files. For music, send lyrics, scanned sheet music or sound files. For art, send as bitmap or gif files. Send text as a word processing file or as a pdf. Texts which contain Hebrew and/or graphics must be sent as pdf or related type file.
5. To keep our site "reader friendly," please keep paragraphs short.
6. Please submit material you are comfortable sharing with the public. If you want to post something in our password protected section for members only, please contact Rabbi Pam Frydman Baugh at pbrydman@yahoo.com for details.
7. All submissions must comport with the ALEPH Statement of Principles and OHALAH's Mission Statement contained in Article IV of the OHALAH constitution that is available at <http://www.ohalah.org/Ohalah-new/aboutohalah.html>, and are subject to approval by Rachel Barenblat, OHALAH Web Volunteer.
8. If your membership in OHALAH is terminated or called into question for any reason, including non-payment of dues, articles you have submitted may be removed from our website.
